## Pathway

Traditional/vocational route - mixture of GCSE and vocational qualifications with a choice of two subjects studied over 2 years including French or Spanish and geography or history

Education, Apprenticeships or Training until 18
Pathways: FE - sixth form or College
A Level or Technical courses.
T Levels: T Levels are new 2-year courses which are taken after GCSEs and are broadly equivalent in size to 3 A Levels.

# Making the right GCSE Choices 

## LONG TERM GOALS - certain degree courses require specific A levels

| Degree level course | A level subjects often required |
| :--- | :--- |
| Biology | Biology and another science or maths |
| Chemistry | Chemistry and sometimes maths and/or <br> another science |
| Dentistry | Chemistry and one or two other sciences |
| Engineering | Maths and physics (or maths and chemistry for <br> chemical engineering) |
| Maths | Maths |
| Medicine | Chemistry and usually one or two other <br> sciences. Some require biology |
| Modern languages | Usually the language to be studied - but this <br> may vary for less common languages |
| Veterinary Science | Chemistry and one or two other sciences |
