Warm weather

Just a reminder as the warmer weather is now upon us.

Students are encouraged to bring a refillable water bottle with them each day and refill them before school, breaktimes and lunchtimes. Sadly we cannot provide students with plastic cups.

We ask that you ensure that students apply an all day suncream before coming to school. Students are encouraged to bring a hat/sunglasses to wear outside on the playground. These should be removed when they return to the building.

Our building does get very warm in the summer - especially the top floors. Students are reminded that the jumper is the optional piece of uniform and should be removed first if too warm. If students remain too warm, then they are permitted to remove their blazers. We should not see students with jumpers on and no blazer.

We do permit small hand held fans - as long as they do not contain water and students do not use them to distract from learning.

Blackwell Adventure Trip - Year 9/Year 10 GCSE

Just a reminder that the Blackwell Adventure trip will be taking place this Tuesday (14/05/2024).

Pupils will need to make sure they have brought their own food and drinks to consume throughout the day and are reminded to wear appropriate clothing for the activities. We recommend pupils wear comfortable clothing and footwear that they are able to move easily in (PE kit or own sports clothing, including trainers) as activities will include climbing and maneuvering through various obstacles. We suggest not wearing jeans or any open toes/unsupportive shoes.

We also advise pupils to come prepared for all weather possibilities as the forecast is currently showing both sun and showers so please make sure they have a jacket, such as a raincoat, sun cream and a hat with them.
