Wider personal development - update on September opportunities

In September, our students have taken part in a variety of opportunities. Year 12 students attended Aston University to get a taste of life at university and understand the skills required to successfully transition to study at Higher Education. Our Year 11 Physicists took part in a special study day at the Kings Edwards School, working alongside other students in the trust, they took part in activities around sustainable energy and possible careers paths in the industry. There was a theatre trip to see 'An inspector calls for Year 10 and 11 English students. This was organised to help students understand how the play is performed on stage in preparation for their GCSE as this text is compulsory as part of the literature examination. Year 13 Geographers went to Carding Mill valley for a field trip where they collected vital data needed for their assessments. Finally, some of our year 9 students had a day of media literacy training provided by The Guardian Foundation in order to help them understand the skills for employability. These students will be media literacy ambassadors during the careers value day that is taking place on 17th October. There are already lots of enrichment opportunities currently in the pipeline for October, such as the Year 7 Foundation ceremony, Year 13 trip to the Houses of Parliament and the Supreme Court in London.
