Dear Parent/Carer,

The Art Department is planning a visit to Liverpool for art and photography students in years 10, 11 and 13 to view work first hand in two galleries. The observations and recordings made during this trip will offer an opportunity to enhance their GCSE and A Level exam component.

The visit will take place on Wednesday 12th February 2025, the trip will cost £18 to cover the transport to the venues. The deadline for payment via Kevi LSG app will be Thursday 6th of February. The galleries we are visiting are free to enter so the only other money students will require is for food and drink throughout the day. Students can, of course, bring their own refreshments and are advised to bring some for the coach journey on the way there.

On the day of the trip, your son/daughter will need to be in school to register by 7.00 am. The coach will be departing at 7.30am in order to keep to the schedule for the day; heavy traffic at that time of day means that we will not be able to wait for any late comers. Students should wear comfortable clothing as we will be spending a lot of time travelling and then the majority of time in Liverpool on our feet. We request that students should also check the weather carefully the night before and, depending on the forecast, bring suitable items such as hats and scarves or an umbrella. So that your son/daughter can record aspects of the trip that they feel will support their studies, we would like students to bring a small notepad or sketchbook and a camera (a camera on his/her phone is ideal). We will be leaving Liverpool at approximately 4.00pm so should arrive back to school between 6.30pm and 7pm. We will advise the students when we are half an hour away from school and ask them to phone you to collect them. If your son/daughter has permission to walk home from school, please write a separate note for their teacher to collect on the day.

If your son/daughter requires any medication they will need to bring it with them on the trip and make the first aider accompanying us aware of any needs at the start of the day.
