The bar will be open for students to purchase soft drinks only, please note that they can accept card payments only – students will not be able to pay in cash. We will be operating a strict no alcohol policy; any students suspected of consuming alcohol prior to the event will be refused entry and parents will be asked to collect them.

In order to secure a place for your daughter at what promises to be a very special event, we ask that you pay a non-refundable deposit of £20. Payments can be made via the LGS app. In order to proceed with this booking.

The option for payment will be made available from Friday 31st January 2025.

Please pay your deposit by Friday 28th March 2025. The deadline for payment of all monies is Friday 23rd May 2025.

Whilst we think very highly of your daughter and are sure that she is fully aware of the school's high expectations, we reserve the right to prevent any students from attending this year's Prom if there are serious breaches of our codes of behaviour between now and the end of Year 11. It is also worth noting that, due to capacity limitations at the venue and seating/eating arrangements, only Year 11 students and staff from Lordswood School for Girls will be able to attend; students will not be able to invite additional guests.
