

KEVI LSG APP

The KEVI LSG App will allow you

- Access timetables
- Access behaviour and reward points
- Check attendance
- Report students absences

We use StudyBugs to record absence.

LUNCH TIME

KING EDWARD VI LORDSWOOD SCHOOL FOR GIRLS

- Lunchtime is 45 minutes
- Students take it in turns to have first lunch sitting
- Lunchtime is fast but settles quickly.
- Always food left at the end.
- The cards must be topped up by KEVI LSG App (can set up auto-top up)
- If the card gets lost, replacement cards are £3.50 each
- Students must inform the canteen staff immediately if card is lost.
- Free school meal cards are the same.

UNIFORM

- Blazers must be brought to school every day, can be reflected only if the optional jumper has already been removed.

- We do not allow jewellery to be worn except one religious item and one pair of plain silver or gold studs in the earlobe
- We do not allow students to wear any make-up
- Plain black shoes (no trainers except for PE)
- Skirt must be knee length and not 'stretch' material.
- Trousers must be below the ankle.
- Plain hair accessories and natural hair colour
- Year badge will be provided in September
- Any school bag/winter coat
- Black or navy socks/tights
- Plain navy blue headscarf
