Year 10 Mock Examinations - Week commencing 9th June 2025

Dear Year 10 Parents

During the week commencing Monday 9th June your child will be having their End of Year Examinations. The link below is a timetable for the week. Please make sure that you and your child are aware which examinations they have each day and that they are prepared for them and go equipped with the correct equipment.

Here are some quick reminders of how students should behave in their examinations:

- Be ready by being equipped - Make sure that they come to the examinations with all the equipment that they require for it, there is limited equipment to be lent out and especially with calculators it may not be the brand or model they are used to using.
- Be ready to start - Make sure that they are arriving to examinations on time so that we can get them seated and ready to start the exam punctually.
- Be respectful and silent - Make sure that students understand the need to be silent from the point that they enter the examination hall or classroom until they have left the room after their examination.
- Be respectful to their environment by sitting in the correct seat and understand the need to follow the instructions given by the invigilators.
- Be resilient by trying their best - we want every student to leave every exam being able to say to themselves - I tried my hardest in that and gave it my all.
