Tuesday 16th December - Santa Dash

Please only send packaged items e.g. beans, sugar, soup, biscuits, long life milk, toiletries, nappies, squash. Please do not send fresh/perishable items as these have a limited shelf life.

Items that students might choose to wear could include: a Christmas jumper instead of their school jumper, a tinsel scarf, red/green hair bobbles/headscarf, christmas tights/socks, red/green shoes, a Christmas hat... they must however wear the rest of their uniform as normal.

Christmas dinner will be served on Wednesday. If you wish your child to have a Christmas dinner, please ensure that they have enough money on their lunch card.
