## Uniform Reminders

Thank you to all the students who come to school in immaculate uniform every day. Whenever our students go out on visits we receive compliments about how smartly presented our students are. It is also one of the first things that visitors comment on when visiting the school. Sadly however, we have started to see a few students who are not following the uniform guidance.

The first is skirts. The uniform policy is very clear that skirts should be knee length and not rolled. We are seeing an increasing number of students who are rolling their skirts despite being reminded or wearing skirts that are significantly shorter than knee length. If your daughter wears a skirt to school, please can you check that they haven't had a growth spurt and need a new skirt.

Year badges - we have seen an increase in the number of students not wearing their year badge. These are essential to the organisation of numerous systems in school. If they have lost their badge, a new one can be purchased from reception for the cost of £1.50.

Can we remind parents that our uniform policy is very specific with regards to jewellery. We only permit 1 plain silver or gold piercing in the lobe of each ear - these should not be diamonds or shaped. We do not permit any other piercings - including nose piercings. Please do not let your daughter have her nose pierced in term time as they will be asked to remove it. Please wait till the start of the summer holidays when there will be enough time for it to heal - it can then be removed each day for school without the risk of it closing over.
